Many of those who live here grew up and have lived in Todmorden and surrounding areas for their whole lives. This means that our home has a natural community feel, with people often becoming neighbours all over again and continuing their lifelong friendships.

Our philosophy of care

Everyone we care for is treated as an individual and is cared for with dignity, respect and empathy.

Dementia friendly

Pennine Lodge is a dementia-friendly setting. The walls of our communal areas are decorated with dementia-friendly wall art. This is painted in traditional colours for an authentic appearance - creating a nostalgic atmosphere which promotes reminiscence and brings back happy memories. We have created a shopping area, with a post office, newsagent, tea shop, bar and library that stimulate the senses and encourage people to be active. The environment gives our ladies and gentlemen a real sense of purpose, and they often go to pick up a newspaper after breakfast or entertain the family at the tea shop.



Modern facilities

Our home has three units - William, Harrison and Ryland, which are situated over two floors of our Edwardian manor house. There are 38 single bedrooms, large communal dining areas on both floors and a further small dining area on the ground floor.

Several large stylish, and comfortable lounges allow our ladies and gentlemen to socialise and relax with friends or family in a community setting.

Bespoke services

We are proud to provide a wide range of tailored services, including, occupational therapy, psychology support, speech and language therapy, behavioural specialist therapy, physiotherapist, nutritionist, on-site laundry, daily stimulating and meaningful activities and events, end of life care, and community services such as chiropody, psychiatry, GP services, district nurses and complimentary therapies*.

Philosophy of care

Pennine Lodge is run by highly qualified multidisciplinary care professionals who provide holistic care to people living with dementia, mental health issues, complex behaviours that may be triggered by stress or distress, physical and/or emotional care needs.

We believe in focusing on what individuals can do instead of what they can't and celebrating life to the fullest. This philosophy makes Pennine Lodge a flourishing, welcoming and happy community.
